



GIVE A GIFT TO MID-OHIO FOOD COLLECTIVE THROUGH YOUR IRA

Make a tax-free gift by supporting Mid-Ohio Food Collective through your IRA.

To make an IRA gift through a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) to Mid-Ohio Food Collective, you must be at least 70½ years of age.

Beginning at age 73, account holders are required to make annual withdrawals from their IRA's, known as Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs).

HOW TO MAKE A CHARITABLE DONATION WITH AN IRA QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION (QCD) OR A REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTION (RMD)

- Contact your IRA administrator about the process to initiate a QCD or RMD
- Use our legal name Mid-Ohio Food Collective
- (Mid-Ohio Foodbank dba Mid-Ohio Food Collective)
- Include our federal tax identification number | 31-0865343
- The check must be made payable directly to Mid-Ohio Food Collective
- IRA distributions do not always include donor contact information when the checks are sent from the plan administrator
- Ask the plan administrator to include your name, address, and any special instructions within the documentation accompanying the check and/or include your name on the check
- To ensure you receive a proper acknowledgment your name must be associated with the IRA distribution

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF NAMING A CHARITY AS THE BENEFICIARY OF YOUR IRA?

- Naming a beneficiary for your IRA is a critical estate planning step
- You can name individuals and/or Mid-Ohio Food Collective as part of your legacy
