

How to get a Senior Food Box- Franklin Co



The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) is a federal program that provides eligible seniors with a MONTHLY box of shelf-stable items. It includes a variety of meats and fruits/vegetables, juice, cereal, pasta, peanut butter, and cheese.

You must be **at least 60 years of age**, have a **household gross income at or below 150% of the federal poverty guidelines**, and **reside in the county in which you apply**.

In Franklin County, home delivery is provided to seniors. Mid-Ohio Food Collective (MOFC) maintains a network of community partners that are trained to refer eligible seniors into the program. Below is a list of agencies that can be contacted to create an appointment for the referral process.

What steps do you need to take?

1. Call the agency of your choice to make an appointment for submitting a referral.
2. At the appointment, bring a valid drivers license, state ID, birth certificate, or other federally approved document to verify your identity AND a piece of mail to verify your address.
 - If you are bringing a drivers license with your current address on it, you do not need to bring a supplemental piece of mail.
