

What is CSFP?



The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) is a federal program that provides eligible seniors with a MONTHLY box of shelf-stable items. It includes a variety of meats and fruits/vegetables, juice, cereal, pasta, peanut butter, and cheese.

To qualify for CSFP, the individual must:

- Be 60 or older
- Self-declare income at or under 150% of the federal poverty guidelines (updated yearly)
- Reside in the county where you apply and that is served by the Mid-Ohio Food Collective
